This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey approval of the Board for Affiliation Up to Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The number of sections of Bal- Vatika shall be restricted to 3 (One section each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively) and total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 21 from class I to X. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension.
2	In the latest fire safety certificate dated 03.11.2023 the area is mentioned 0.37 (measuring unit is not mentioned), hence is cannot be established that the fire safety certificate obtained for complete school building. School shall submit an undertaking that the said fire safety certificate obtained covers the complete school structure and submit the same in complinace within 03 months.
3	CwSN toilet for Girls is specious but for Boys on first floor is developed temporary, it is a urinal partition converted into CWSN toilets but it is very narrow and there is no room for a

	wheelchair/walker to navigate. Thus, School shall construct the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair as well as handrail on both side of toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per guidelines of the Board and norms of RPwD Act 2016 within 03 months and submit the compliance.
4	The ramp for first floor is completed but the ramp for second floor is still under construction. School shall ensure that the construction is completed within 03 months and submit the compliance.
5	In Composite Science Lab only three workstations are developed one for each section of Biology, Physics and Chemistry. The workstations are not adequate to accommodate and conduct practical of 40 students at once. Piped Gas supply made on a workstation but Gas Cylinder is placed in the same lab which is not safe. School shall increase the workstation with the facilities of fixtures along with the seating capacity and upgrade the lab in the light of SoP for labs issued by the Board within 03 months and submit compliance.
6	School is not running Balvatika as per NEP. In compliance to the recommendation of NCF-FS-2022 school shall start balvatika as per circular 12/2023 from the upcoming session 2024-25.
7	Sufficient Computers are now installed in the computer lab but the lab appears undersized. The furniture provided for Computer systems have not enough space. The benches have been provided for seating in place of the computer chair. No LMC, Speaker, Webcam and projector is found installed in the lab. School shall upgrade the computer lab with appropriate furniture and in a big room in the light of SoP for labs issued by the Board within 03 months and submit compliance.
8	Math lab is understocked. Few aids, models and kits are placed on a big table as makeshift arrangement. Seating arrangement is also not adequate for the lab to accommodate 40 students at a time. School shall set up the lab in the light of SoP for labs issued by the Board within 03 months and submit compliance.
9	The school shall ensure the mandatory training of its teachers with CoE, Guwahati, within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws- 2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.

5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
